IMPORTANT INFORMATION

DRESS

Please read the information about school dress codes. We believe the proper appearance in class is essential for effective dance education. This includes hair and good grooming for all classes. All students must wear cover-ups outside before and after class.

STUDENT CONCERT

All students must be enrolled in their classes by November 1st in order to participate in the dance concert. No refunds will be given on costumes after that date.

STUDIOS

Street shoes are not allowed in the dance studios. Students must be supervised before and after classes. No running or playing on the steps is allowed. Younger students are asked to wait downstairs for the instructor before classes. Parents may be charged late fee if student is not picked up within 15 minutes of the last evening class.

MAKE-UP CLASSES

Students are welcome to make up any missed classes in a level lower than their current level.

BEHAVIOR

Northwest Florida Ballet students are expected to treat their instructors and peers with kindness and respect. NFB reserves the right to dismiss students if necessary.

COSTUMES

Concert costumes are ordered to size based on student measurements. Families are responsible for any further alterations.

EN POINTE CAUTION

Students are not placed in pointe classes until our instructors are sure their training has progressed to the appropriate level to avoid injury. Young children should never be allowed to have pointe shoes as playthings.

GIRL'S BALLET

Creative Dance	Pink silkskin short sleeved leotard (Motionwear style#2104)/ white socks/ pink full sole slippers
Pre-Ballet	Light Blue silkskin short sleeved leotard (Motionwear style#2104)/ white socks/ pink full sole slippers
Level 1 & 2	Ultra violet silkskin short sleeved leotard (Motionwear style#2104)/ pink tights/ pink full sole slippers
Level 3 & 4	Hunter silkskin plain camisole leotard (Motionwear style#2515)/ pink tights/ pink ballet slippers
Level 5	Any solid color leotard (Motionwear style#2516)/ pink tights/ pink ballet slippers
Company	Black leotard (Motionwear style#2511)/ pink tights/ pink ballet slippers
Trainee	Black leotard (Motionwear style#2516)/ pink tights/ pink ballet slippers

BOY'S BALLET

Creative & Pre-Ballet	Black cotton biker shorts/black ballet slippers/white socks/white T-shirt
Levels 1-5	Black or grey cotton leggings or tights/black or white ballet slippers/white socks/white T-shirt

JAZZ

Girls	Black jazz booties or ballet slippers - leather with neoprene or elastic (no sneakers for jazz) Leotard - refer to ballet levels or black Bottoms - black V-Front biker shorts (Motionwear style #7113) or black capris (Motionwear style #7164)
Boys	Black jazz booties or ballet slippers, black tights or jazz pants, T-shirt

CHARACTER

Girls	Ballet attire, character skirt (Body Wrappers style#511), character shoes (Capezio style#550) Ballet or Jazz attire and jazz shoes
Boys	

MODERN

Leotard	Refer to ballet levels or black
Tights	Pink or black footless

HIP HOP

Girls	Form fitting top, black split sole sneakers, pants of choice
Boys	Black split sole sneakers, T-shirt, pants of choice

PILATES

Comfortable exercise attire. No shoes or loose clothing.

ADULT CLASSES

Appropriate workout attire

FOOTWEAR

Students should begin ballet with a full leather-soled pink shoe by Capezio or Bloch

HAIR

Girls must have their hair in a bun for all ballet classes

NOTES:

Solid dark or matching skirts may be worn in pointe class. Pink waist length ballet sweaters are allowed in ballet classes. No sport bras, pants (girls), Softe shorts, loose T-shirts or midriff tops in any classes.

Tuition is due on the first day of each month, August—May. \$10 late fee will be charged after the 15th. *Trimester and Yearly fees must be paid by the 15th of the first month to receive discounts.

FAMILY DISCOUNT

Student in the family with the most classes pays full tuition. Each additional family member will receive \$5 off tuition each month, and \$10 off each additional concert fee for the year.

STUDENT CONCERT FEES

Concert Fee: \$50 per student (includes theatre and production expenses, due upon registration)

Costume Fees: Ballet-\$50 per costume
All other classes-\$60 per costume

All concert and costume fees are due upon registration for student to perform in concert. No refunds for concert or costume fees after November 1
